To apply for this scholarship, please do the following:


1. Read the **Requirements** to ensure that you qualify.

Requirements:

Each applicant must meet the following requirements to be considered for this scholarship:

- **Be a senior athlete (member of a high school team).**
- **Have a minimum, cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.**
- **Have demonstrated community service, leadership in school and extracurricular activities.**


